



VICO MAGISTRETTI

Best known for the 1967-designed Eclisse, Vico Magsitretti was born in Italy in 1920. Trained as an architect, his lifelong passion was minimal, usable design which he implemented in large building projects as well as intimately-scaled fixtures and furnishings for noted companies such as Artemide, Flou and Kartell throughout his 60-year career.





IDENTITY

Inspired by the age of experimenting materials in lighting, Eclisse identifies strongly with Artemide's Human Light philosophy that places men and the pursuit of their well being at the core of research and development.





ICON

What makes the Eclisse iconic is its adaptation of natural eclipsing movement from as early as the 60's. It is a recognizable piece, that has left a revered mark in lighting design.



AVANT-GARDE

Designed by Vico Magistretti in 1967, the Eclisse is an avant-garde balance between form and function, design and utility. The concept's foundation lies in Eclisse's functionality of adjusting the intensity of light through its rotating inner shade that "eclipses" the light source.


